The Health Transition Team supports young people who are making the journey into adulthood. We help young people with long term physical impairments and those with certain conditions including severe asthma, eczema and allergies.

Working with you

Jade, Jordan, Brad and Zak come from different parts of Walsall, have different backgrounds and want to achieve different things in their lives.

What they share is that they have all experienced Walsall Healthcare's Health Transition Team.

Jade said "I've made lots of new friends with my condition. It's helped me grow as a person"



Jordan said: "The team has given me more confidence in myself and I'm able to communicate with others outside of the workshops. I've made closer friends with the team because they know what we've been through and I'm grateful for the support that the team has given me."

Brad said: "I can now get more involved in my doctor's appointments so it's been very beneficial for me".



Zak said: "The transition service has helped me to say positive. It's made me more confident and more assertive. You don't know what the service has to offer until you have tried it."

What we do

We offer support and advice to young people who have a physical impairment and some long term conditions such as Type 1 Diabetes, severe Asthma, Allergies and Eczema, and are moving from children's services to adult services.

We offer this to all young people from Walsall from Year Nine onwards who are in mainstream education.

We offer support to Young People (14-25years) who have:

- A long term physical health condition, generally in local mainstream schools with mild or no associated Learning Disability.
- A long term condition such as Type 1 Diabetes, Severe Asthma, Eczema, and Allergies - known to the Specialist Community Nursing Team or the Hospital Diabetes team
- We help young people to gain access to services available within health, leisure and social care.
- We help young people to put together their own Health Passport used to support them in health, education and work.
